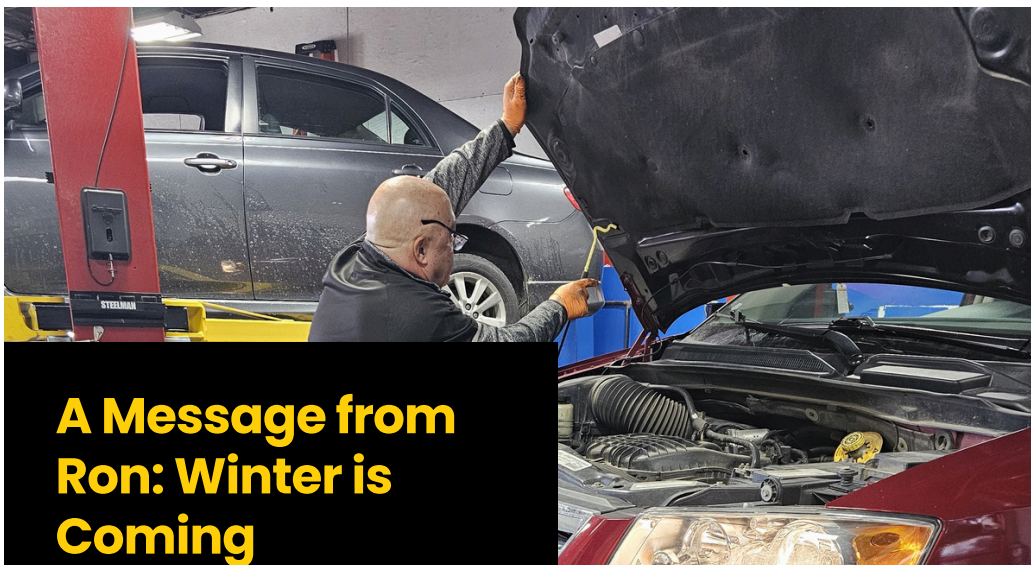

Swap to winter tires, check tread depth and pressure, and don't forget fresh wiper blades with washer fluid rated for freezing temps.

I also recommend keeping an emergency kit with a blanket, gloves, scraper, flashlight, and jumper cables in your car—just in case. Stay safe and prepared this winter!

Fall Specials & Community Support

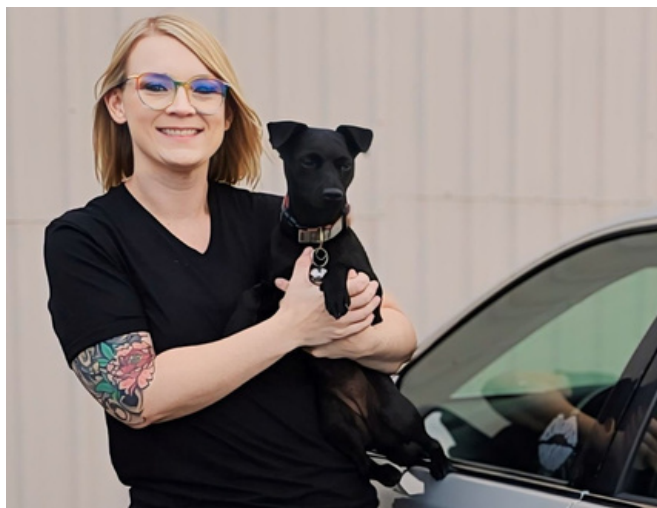
Ron's Garage is keeping vehicles safe this fall with our Backfield Blitz Giveaway & Service Specials.
